Growing up in a family of troubled women (Matousek's sister committed suicide when the author was 29), he describes the turmoil of growing up fatherless in America - an experience shared by millions of children in what sociologists have called the Age of the Absent Father - and the difficult, ultimately successful, struggle to figure out what being a man really means in an age of shifting definitions, evolving sexuality, and breaking out the man box of stereotyping and patriarchy.
